

The feeling of missing someone also arouses a feeling of gratitude. It is a multi-layered sensation that can be both painful and comforting




### Ingénue, 2022

Cupido connects the material with the immaterial and refers to the sublime. His predominantly black-and-white works are timeless. The choice of high quality, durable printing techniques matches the content of his works







### Moon Addict II, 2021

The artist's affinity for the natural world was born out of a childhood spent on the Dutch island of Terschelling, where the ebb and flow of tides and the cycles of the moon reflect the fleetingness of life








### Solandes, 2018

Cupido's work is inspired by Japanese photography. Japanese philosophical principles, especially that of mu, permeate his creative practice. Mu could be loosely translated as 'does not have' or 'void', albeit one that holds potential







## Mu #6, 2022 Advocates propose mu as a way of breaking through the 'conceptual fog' that can get in the way of experience or enlightenment. Cupido says: 'My stylistic categories encompass landscape, portraiture and still life. I prefer to work with analogue film but also shoot digital, photographing widely on my travels and reflecting on the results later, enabling a renewed journey of discovery'




### Juliet 00, 2022

A recurring element in Cupido's work is the human body as part of nature. In his conceptual series of ginkgo leaves, the plant captivates the artist not only for its aesthetic appeal but also as a symbol of longevity. The artist has photographed more than 200 ginkgo leaves to date







### Pendulum III, 2022

Cupido's camera is more than a tool; he uses it to capture the ephemeral, to experience the world and visualise his view of outside and inside. The medium of photography offers Cupido the opportunity to confront himself and connect with the world







### Cactus, 2022

Cupido's work is a deeply personal exploration of the human quest for inner peace, a quest that is taken in the knowledge that quiet resignation is so often followed by renewed turmoil







### Stay With Me, 2022

Cupido says: 'I aim to engage with the world with wide-open senses. My work is about the magic moments of life as well as its inconveniences. I want to take pictures while forgetting about the process of photography, until I'm saturated with an existential sense of life'
